

TECHNICAL SERVICE BULLETIN Gear Shift Module (GSM) Concerns

This bulletin supersedes 25-2324. Reason for update: update the Service Procedure

Model:

| Ford | Built on or before 08-Sep-2025 |

Markets: North American markets only

Issue: Some of the vehicles listed in the Model statement above equipped with a console <u>GSM</u> may exhibit at least one of the following conditions:

- Clicking sound coming from shifter after it is placed and kept in reverse, neutral or drive position (2024 only)
- Shifter will not shift out of park/into park
- · Shifter will not shift out of gear
- · Shifter will not stow/unstow
- · Shifter will move past the park position
- Loose shifter lever arm at pivot
- Illuminated powertrain malfunction (wrench) indicator with active <u>DTCs</u> P0929:77, P0929:00, P0929:07 and/or P0929:9A stored in the <u>GSM</u>

This may be due to the GSM.

NOTE: If the gear shifter lever will not shift into park, the transmission will automatically shift into park when the return to park function is triggered.

Action: For vehicles that meet the criteria in the Issue and Model statements above, follow the Service Procedure to replace the <u>GSM</u>.

Service Procedure

- **1.** With the system in Ready to Drive mode/engine running, apply and release the brake pedal while observing BRK_PDL_SW2 <u>PID</u> in the <u>BCM</u>. Does the BRK_PDL_SW2 <u>PID</u> change status when the brake pedal is pressed and released?
 - (1). Yes proceed to Step 2.
 - (2). No diagnose the brake pedal switch output and repair outside of this article. Refer to WSM, Section 307-05.
- 2. Is the vehicle built on or before 08-Sep-2025?
 - (1). Yes proceed to Step 3.
 - (2). No This article does not apply. Refer to WSM, Section 307-05.
- **3.** Remove the left console trim to inspect the <u>GSM</u> build date. Refer to <u>WSM</u>, Section 501-12. (Figure 1) Figure 1



4. Verify the GSM build date/Julian Date. Refer to Table 1.

- Calendar Year = 2024.
- Julian Date = 85th day of 2024.
- Build date of GSM = 25-Mar-2024.
- 5. Is the shifter built on or before 28-Aug-2025?
 - (1). Yes proceed to Step 6.
 - (2). No this article does not apply. Refer to WSM, Section 307-05 for normal diagnostics.
- **6.** Replace the <u>GSM</u>. Refer to <u>WSM</u>, Section 307-05. <u>WSM</u>, Section 307-05 includes performing the <u>PMI</u> procedure to install the latest strategy files and carry out the <u>TRON</u> Module Authentication Procedure for 2024-2025 vehicles using the <u>FDRS</u>.
